The SCAIC has been working on an international survey, “Global Cardiac Anesthesia Workforce Assessment,” which aims to assess what our training background and requirements are, practice setting, work environment, a few questions on practice, and work-life balance. This is the first ever on such a large, truly global-scale survey of the cardiac anesthesia community. The preliminary results will be presented at the ICCVA/SCA/CASSA meeting in Cape Town, South Africa, in December, and the results will be published after that. The data will be made available to all participating societies. The information gained should be highly valuable and of interest to all cardiac anesthesia societies and cardiac anesthesiologists.

At this point, the survey is finalized and we have started to launch worldwide via society’s emails to active membership at large, social media, and personal contacts.
